Product Description

The Toe Chair Armrest is where sculpture becomes a place to sit. Born from the bold optimism of 1970s space-age design, its rounded silhouette and thick fluted upholstery shape generous volumes that feel both expressive and serene.

Seat and backrest are formed from layers of premium foam, creating flowing contours that gently embrace the body while maintaining a strong architectural presence. Solid Classic Brown Oak armrests introduce a warm material counterpoint - crafted from FSC-certified American Red Oak, shaped like subtle wings and finished in natural warm brown tones, they offer natural hand support and a practical resting surface, developing a rich patina over time.

The 100% wool velvet upholstery brings a richly textured surface that shifts gently with the light, creating subtle depth and movement. Soft and inviting to the touch, it combines natural warmth and resilience with a refined character suited to both private interiors and high-use environments. In Peat - a deep smoky brown touched with dark grey - the velvet carries the quiet language of the earth, grounding the warm oak tones in a layered composition of warmth and shadow.

Equally at home as a sculptural statement piece or part of a larger seating composition, the Toe Chair Armrest pairs naturally with the Toe Sofa Armrest and Toe Ottoman to create a cohesive landscape of soft architectural comfort.

Designer Description

Tommy Hyldahl and Kristian Sofus Hansen intertwine their distinct sensibilities to create designs where storytelling, materiality, and timeless form meet in quiet harmony.

With a background in fashion, Tommy brings an intuitive eye for trends, colors, and textures. Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



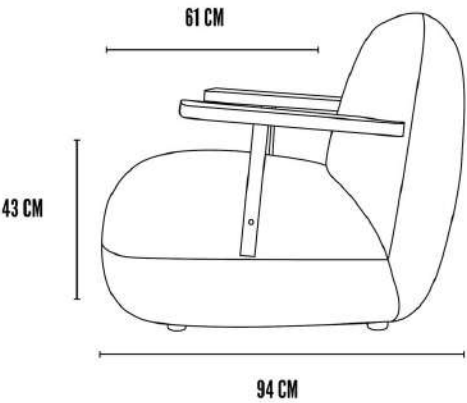
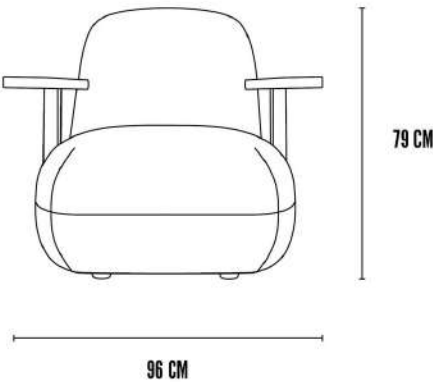

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Family Description Text

The Toe Series is more than a collection of lounge furniture. It is an ode to the bold optimism of the 1970s space age, reimagined for contemporary living. Here furniture becomes sculpture and comfort becomes a form of architecture. Thick, fluted upholstery flows across seamless forms like a soft rhythm, shaping generous volumes that feel both expressive and serene.

Defined by rounded geometries and sculptural proportions, the series shares a unified language of tactile softness and effortless comfort. Seats and backrests are shaped from layers of premium foam, creating flowing contours that gently embrace the body while maintaining a strong architectural presence.

Most pieces express the purity of the upholstered form, including the Toe Ottoman, Toe Lounge, Toe Armchair and Toe Flat. The Toe Armrest Chair and Toe Sofa Armrest introduce a contrasting architectural element through solid oak armrests for indoor settings or teak for outdoor environments. Formed from thick planks and shaped like subtle wings, they provide natural support for the hand while also serving as a practical resting surface for everyday essentials.

Together the Toe Series transforms interiors into spaces of imagination where the spirit of futurism meets contemporary craftsmanship. More than seating, it is comfort shaped into sculpture and design distilled into poetry.

Color Description

This pairing brings together the rich warmth of Classic Brown Oak with the grounded depth of Peat. The oak's natural grain and warm brown tones add texture and character, while Peat introduces a deep smoky brown touched with dark grey, creating a sense of quiet depth. The tone recalls soil that has remembered centuries, weathered wood, and the calm hush of damp earth after rain.

Together they form a layered composition of warmth and shadow, where the organic texture of oak meets the earthy richness of Peat. The result feels timeless and grounded, balancing natural character with a calm and sophisticated depth.

Maintenance Guide Description

Velvet adds softness, depth, and elegance to furniture, and with gentle care it will maintain its rich appearance for many years. To keep the fabric looking fresh, lightly brush the surface with a soft upholstery brush or cloth in the direction of the pile. This helps maintain the velvet's natural sheen and prevents the fibers from flattening.

Dust can be removed with a vacuum cleaner using a soft brush attachment on a low setting. In case of spills, act quickly and gently blot the area with a clean cloth. Avoid rubbing, as this can push the stain deeper into the fibers. Minor marks can often be treated with a slightly damp cloth and left to air dry naturally.

Pressure marks from use can be softened by lightly steaming the fabric from a distance and gently brushing the fibers back into place once dry. To preserve the color and texture, keep velvet furniture away from prolonged direct sunlight and rotate cushions occasionally to ensure even wear.

Warnings: Avoid harsh chemicals, strong detergents, or abrasive brushes, as these can damage the velvet fibers. Do not soak the fabric or apply excessive water. Always test any cleaning method on a small, hidden area first. For deeper cleaning or persistent stains, professional upholstery cleaning is recommended to protect the fabric's texture and finish.

Materials Description

This piece brings together the natural strength of oak with the soft richness of velvet, creating a balance between structure and comfort.

Our wooden furniture begins with American Red Oak, a living material with a story in every grain. FSC certified and responsibly sourced, this hardwood carries the quiet strength of the forests it comes from. Naturally resilient and long lasting, it matures over time, developing a rich patina that reflects years of use and care. Oak's tight grain and inherent strength make it ideal for everyday living, while its warm tones and textured surface add a grounded and refined beauty. We work with the wood respectfully, allowing its natural stability to guide sculptural forms with bold lines, soft curves, and details that highlight its character.

Paired with the oak is velvet upholstery, crafted from 100% wool. The dense pile creates a smooth, soft surface that gently catches the light, adding depth and movement to the color. Soft to the touch yet highly durable, the fabric offers both comfort and resilience, making it well suited for furniture in private homes as well as high use environments such as hotels and lounges.

Together, oak and velvet create a harmonious dialogue between strength and softness, where natural structure meets tactile warmth in a composition that feels both timeless and inviting.
